5. CURRENT PLANNING ISSUES – the following applications will be considered and comments agreed for submission to Tandridge District Council.
 - 5.1. TA/2020/1393/TCA - Obberds, Church Walk, Bletchingley RH1 4PD. (AD)
Cypress - (T1) - Reduce and Thin Crown; Exochorda racemosa (Pearlbush) - (S1) - Remove and replant further away from house wall.
 - 5.2 TA/2020/1284/TPO - Rose Lawn, Big Common Lane, Bletchingley RH1 4QE. (AD)
Horse Chestnut - (T1) - Reduce height by 4m to leave a residual height of 10m. Reduce length of longest lateral branch by 3m. The remaining crown to be pruned in proportion in order to maintain the natural shape.
Sweet chestnut - (T2) - Remove 2x lapsed epicormic shoots (approx. 150mm dia)
Oak - (T3) - Lift crown to 4 metres by removing secondary and sub lateral branches only.
